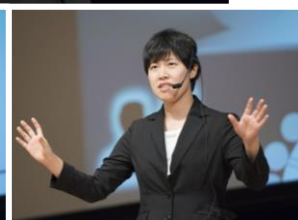

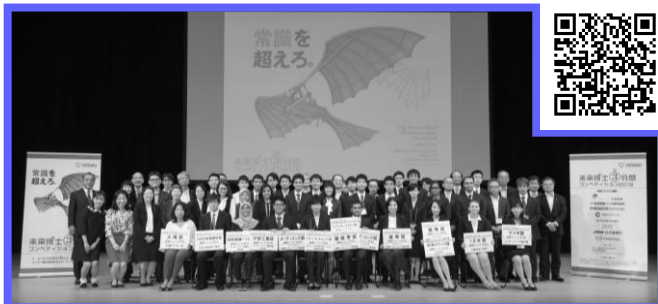
3MT was developed by The University of Queensland and now held in over 600 universities across 65 countries worldwide.
