o Handling of Dishonest Acts during Semester Final Examinations, etc.

(April 1, 2004 Approved by the President)

- 1. Class completion in a relevant semester for an individual who has committed a dishonest act during semester final examinations, etc. shall be handled in the following manner.
 - (1) When an individual has committed a dishonest act during an examination in a liberal arts education course, evaluations for all the liberal arts education courses shall be marked as "poor." However, liberal arts seminars shall be excluded.
 - (2) When an individual has committed a dishonest act during an examination in a specialized education course, evaluations for all the special education courses shall be marked as "poor."
- 2. Disciplinary action shall be taken against an individual who has committed a dishonest act during a semester final examination, etc. in accordance with Hiroshima University Student Disciplinary Regulations (March 7, 2016 Regulation No. 20).
- 3. Matters relevant to semester final examinations, etc. in graduate schools and advanced courses shall be handled according to 1 and 2.

Note: (March 14, 2006 Partial Revision)

- 1. This revision shall be applied from April 1, 2006.
- 2. The provisions then in place regarding the handling of dishonest acts during a semester final examinations, etc. in a liberal arts education course or a specialized education course shall remain applicable, notwithstanding prescriptions regarding the Handling of Dishonest Acts during Semester Final Examinations, etc. revised in accordance with this revision.
