Scholarship for Doctoral Students in the fall Semester of the Academic Year 2020
(2020年度後期 大学院博士課程後期学生奨学金の募集について)

We offer a financial support system which provides superior doctoral students with scholarships for the purpose of reducing their economic burden to continue their study at doctoral course and devote themselves to their research.

1. Eligibility

Applicants must be the doctoral students of the Graduate School of Integrated Sciences for Life in the academic year 2020 and satisfy requirements defined in “2. Application Qualification”.

Applicants must not receive any scholarship of 100,000 yen or more per month (not counting scholarships with obligation of restitution) from government, local government or any other organizations and associations, etc.

2. Application Qualification

Applicants must be those who have excellent academic ability and personality, require economic supports in continuing to study ~~and have applied for tuition exemption in the fall semester 2020~~, but except the following students:

- 1) MEXT scholarship students and foreign government sponsored students
 - 2) Those who have been adopted as JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists (DC1 or DC2)
 - 3) Those who have been enrolled beyond the standard term of study
- ※ Those who are granted full or half tuition exemption will be excluded from the eligible students.

3. Scholarship Amount and Date of Payment

Scholarship Amount: 133,950 yen (Half amount of one semester's tuition fee)

Date of Payment: Expected to be paid by the end of the semester.

4. Application Period and Where to Apply

Application documents must be submitted from November 20 (Fri.), 2020 to November 30 (Mon.), 2020 (9:00 to 12:00 and 13:30 to 16:30) at each program support office.

5. Application Documents

Applicants must submit the following application documents to each program support office:

- 1) Application Form (Form 1)
- 2) Application Details (Form 2)
- 3) Pledge (Form 3) Application forms can be downloaded from the website of the Graduate School of Integrated Sciences for Life- “Student Financial Support”.

6. Announcement of Application Results

After the review of submitted documents, we will announce the result of application around late September.

7. Others

This scholarship will be offered also in the spring semester 2021. If you wish to apply, please be sure to apply for tuition exemption in the spring semester 2021.
