



Water in Sandankyo is super soft (hardness 9.0). The fall's water springs from the top. You can taste it. A kind of alga (Near-Threatened species) colors Akadaki red.

Kurobuchi (Black Pool) and Byobuiwa (Folding Screen Cliff)

Here is one of the most impressive landscapes in Sandankyo.

The depth of the pool is over 5 m. This is why the water looks black, Byobuiwa is looks like a folding screen (Byoubu).

Kurobuchiso Restaurant

This is the only rest house in Sandankyo gorge. It takes about an hour from Nagabuchi entrance.


