Aplication procedure:

The application process is through our online Student Mobility System. If your university has not received a user account and password to access the system, please contact us to ask for an account to be opened at: nvillanueva@global.unam.mx

A System User Guide will be send to your international office, both for you and students, with all the details of the online application process.

The International Office will contact the nominated exchange students and provide all necessary information about the online application procedure. Your international office starts the nomination process on system by "Pre-registering" the nominated students; then the student will receive an e-mail notification with a link to complete application online and upload required documents. Your international office **ends the process** at reviewing and approving application on system; when this is completed, UNAM receives student's application through system as well.
