Language requirements	Programme d'Études Universitaires Françaises Diplôme d'Études Universitaires Françaises (DEUF) for one semester or a full year.
	This program is offered to Bachelor and Masters students coming to study at Lyon 3 for a semester or a year and is run entirely in French. You can choose from classes belonging to a number of different faculties and schools including: business administration, philosophy, languages, law, political science, literature, information & communication, history and geography. The B1 certificate is required for the Programme d'Études Universitaires Françaises students. For level of French language proficiency, we need B1 level for general studies. But the Law faculty and Philosophy faculty need B2 level. If students need take "Communication sciences classes", they should have C1 level If your students don't have French language proficiency, we accept one letter wrote by French language teacher. 	 Academic background: Students should have completed a minimum of two years of university studies; the academic level of SELF corresponds to upper-division undergraduate level Level of French: The SELF semester program is designed for students with a level of French ≤ A2 The SELF annual program is designed for students with an A1 level in French Students staying for two semesters who arrive with an A2 level in French and have attained a B1 level at the end of the semester are directed towards classes taught in French for the spring semester (DEUF program). Level of English: For students enrolled in a university where English is not the official level at the end of the level of the semester of the semester are directed towards classes the end of the semester (DEUF program).
