General information about the university	One of the Taiwan's top leading universities, National Central University (NCU) has been one of the major research-oriented universities since 2001. It is a first-rate university with solid international qualifications. It has gained an international reputation for research and academic excellence. Cooperative education programs and research projects have grown in number over the years. According to the latest 2022 Best Global Universities Rankings announced by the U.S. News & World Report, NCU ranked the 5th among the universities in Taiwan. Notably, in terms of the indicator "international collaboration," it is the 8 <sup>th</sup> year in succession that NCU has stayed the top one among universities in Taiwan.
	Located in Zhongli, NCU covers an area of 62 hectares. We have approximately 12,000 students, and there are 8 colleges, 28 departments, 18 graduate institutes, 5 university-level research centers and one united research center, the Office of Teaching Centers (OTC), and the affiliated Zhongli Senior High School. NCU is truly a comprehensive university of rich scientific and humanistic facilities.
	In addition to constantly making breakthroughs in academic fields, NCU puts emphasis on holistic education, providing students with a platform for self-learning and the realization of their creativity. We also conduct industry-university collaboration and interaction to enable students to engage themselves in autonomous learning, to equip them with professional skills, and to help them develop multiple interests during their study at NCU.
University features	NCU has abundant academic capabilities, with nine areas of strength, including geosciences, engineering, materials science, computer science, physics, chemistry, social sciences, clinical medicine, and environment and ecology, entering the top 1% of the global ESI. The total number of published Nature and Science articles by NCU in the past 10 years is ranked third in Taiwan, and the average number of published faculty articles is the first in Taiwan. In 2021, Google Scholar citations ranked No. 4 in the country, maintaining the momentum of quality academic research and activity. NCU's cross-country collaborations span Asia, Europe, America, and Australia. U.S. News & World Report 2022 ranked NCU the fifth best University in Taiwan, and

	ranked NCU first in the country in the "international cooperation" index for eight consecutive years.
	NCU is actively linking academia and industry to create greater research value. 13 technical submissions were awarded in the Ministry of Science and Technology's "Future Tech Award" in 2021, and another 13 technologies were shortlisted for exhibition. NCU is highly recognized in the fields of space technology, atmospheric science, materials science, biomedical science, cognitive neurology, mechanical engineering, and electrical engineering.
Short description of the city	Taoyuan is located in the northwest of Taiwan. It is bordered both by mountains and the sea, and is thus blessed with stunning landscapes. Taoyuan is also strategically positioned as a traffic hub between north and south. Since early times, it's been a point of convergence for Hoklo and Kakka people. Nowadays, a flourishing economy attracts new inhabitants from farther places. All this has made Taoyuan a unique, multicultural city.
