	NSYSU offers free Chinese language course – 4hrs per week (3 credits) and water sports courses like Yachting, Wind Surfing, Diving, etc. for exchange students.
Short description of the city	Kaohsiung City is a special municipality in southern Taiwan. It ranges from the coastal urban center to the rural Yushan Range. Tropical Monsoon climate with an average temperature of 25°C, with a highest of 35°C in July and a lowest of 12°C in January. Rain and typhoons are usually in the summer months of June -August.

Areas of study open for exchange students	All fields are open to exchange students as long as the student has adequate Chinese proficiency. Otherwise, students can only take courses offered in English. Students are allowed to choose courses from different departments/colleges and levels. Part of the courses in specific study fields is not open to students from other departments/institutes/colleges.
Areas of study NOT available to exchange students	International Ph.D. Program for Science; Master Of Business Administration Program In International Business; Global Human Resource Management English MBA Program does not accept exchange students. Each department could choose to accept or refuse to host exchange students based on the personnel arrangement.
