General information about the university	Sichuan Agricultural University (SAU) was founded in 1906, with a long history of more than 110 years. It is a national "Project 211" key construction university and a national "Double First-Class" construction university with the coordinating development of various disciplines, taking Biotechnology as its feature and Agricultural Science and Technology as its advantage. SAU consists of three campuses: Ya'an, Chengdu, and Dujiangyan, covering a total area of about 750 acres. SAU consists of 26 colleges, 15 research institutes and 1 state key laboratory which cover a variety of academic fields such as Agronomy, Sciences, Engineering, Economics, Management, Medicine, Literature, Education, Law, and Art. Doctoral programs are available in 49 fields, master's programs in 100 fields, and bachelor's programs in 73 fields. In addition, 8 Post-doctoral Research Centers are well equipped. SAU has more than 3600 faculty members, among them 439 professors and 589 associate professors as well as 315 doctoral supervisors and 820 master's supervisors. There are more than 43,000 full-time students, including 36,000 undergraduates, and 7,200 graduate students.
	SAU has outstanding advantages in breeding, cultivation, and deep processing of maize, rice, wheat, peanut, cotton, vegetables, and fruits, as well as in cattle, sheep, swine, aquaculture etc. Animal Nutrition and Feeding, Crop Genetics and Breeding, Animal Genetics and Breeding, and Preventive Veterinary Medicine are four of national keystone disciplines in China. The 4 disciplines of Agricultural Science, Plant & Animal Science, Biology & Biochemistry, and Environmental Science & Ecology are listed in the top 1% of Essential Science Indicators (ESI). Agricultural Science and Veterinary Science entered the first-class disciplines of Global Ranking of Academic Subjects (GRAS) in 2020, ranking among the top 50 and top 51-75 in the world respectively. Highlevel papers in Crop Science has been successively published in the top international academic journals <i>Cell</i> and <i>Science</i> .
	In recent years, under a series of policies to promote the internationalization of SAU, the number of international students has increased rapidly, and all colleges can enroll international students.
	In addition to programs taught in English, undergraduate programs are generally taught in Chinese, while Master' s and Doctoral programs adopt the combination of English instruction and Chinese-English bilingual teaching. The duration of study for undergraduate students is usually 4 or 5 years, and that for graduate students is usually 3 years. After the completion of study, those who pass the examination and the thesis defense will be issued with the graduation certificates, and corresponding degrees shall be awarded after degree review.
	International students can apply for Sichuan Provincial Government Scholarship for International Student, Chengdu Government Scholarship for International Students from Sister

	Cities, Chengdu "Belt and Road" Government Scholarship for International Students, Sichuan Agricultural University Scholarship for Outstanding Student, etc. International students who receive scholarship are required to participate in the annual evaluation of the scholarship, and those who pass the evaluation will continue to receive scholarship for the next academic year. SAU also regularly organizes a series of international and cultural and arts festivals to enrich the campus life of international
	students, such as International Food and Culture Festival, campus cultural activities, Autumn Trip, Traditional Cultural Communication Competition, etc. Through these activities, international students can not only deepen their understanding of Chinese culture, but also show their own cultural characteristics. Rich and colorful
	activities create a strong international atmosphere and promote cultural exchanges between China and foreign countries.
University features	SAU takes biotechnology as its feature and agricultural science and technology as its advantage
Short description of the city	SAU is located in Sichuan, a southwest province in China, which is known as the hometown of giant pandas. The three campuses are located in Ya'an, Chengdu and Dujiangyan City respectively. Ya'an is the birthplace of tea culture and one of the areas in the world where tea trees were planted earliest. Mengding Mountain, located in Mingshan District of Ya'an, enjoys the reputation of the sacred mountain of tea culture.
	Chengdu is the birthplace of ancient Shu civilization, one of the top ten ancient capitals in China. The history of the city can be traced back to 3200 years ago. Chengdu, rich in its culture, is also an important national high-tech industrial base, trade logistics centre and comprehensive transportation hub. Dujiangyan Water Conservancy Project, located in the west of Dujiangyan City, is a world cultural heritage. It has been providing guarantee for agricultural irrigation in Chengdu plain in the last 2000 years.
