A Grant for Taking an English Proficiency Test in the Academic Year 2022 (2022 年度 英語能力検定受験料支援について)

We will accept applications for a grant as shown below for taking English proficiency tests. This grant aims at improving students' English skills to further promote participation in international conferences, research activities and international exchanges.

1. Application Eligibility

Applicants must be master's or doctoral students enrolled at Quantum Matter Program, Graduate School of Advanced Science and Engineering.

2. Tests Applicable for the Grant

In principle, the TOEIC® official test, but other English proficiency tests are also applicable.

3. Application Requirements and Amount of the Grant

1) One person is allowed to make an application for this grant once during "4. Application Period".

2) Regardless of kinds or types of the English proficiency tests, all amount of actual test fee will be granted.

4. Application Period

From October 1, 2022 to January 31, 2023

5. How to Apply

Please fill out an application form, attach the receipt of test fee and get a confirmation seal from your supervisor. Submit the application form with the receipt and "reimbursement invoice(立替払請求書)" form to the Student Support Office of the Quantum Matter Program by "6. Application Deadline". (9:00 ~ 12:00, 13:00 ~ 17:00)

After taking the test, submit the score certificate to the Office. The grant will be paid after the score certificate is submitted.

6. Application Deadline

Application form, receipt and reimbursement invoice form: last weekday before the test date (Applications after taking test will not be accepted.)

Score certificate should be submitted within one week after you receive it.
