

VISA PROCESS

Visa Application	Accepted exchange students will receive a letter of admission for the German embassy. Students coming to Germany will have to apply for a student visa via the Germany embassy in their home countries. The visa process might take up to six weeks .
	After arrival in Münster, students from Non-EU countries with a stay longer than 3 months have to apply for a residence permit (costs about 100 €). Detailed information will be sent to all incoming exchange students.
Financial Certification	A financial certification is required for the visa application. Detailed information is available at the German embassy in each country.

Intensive German Language Courses	The University of Münster offers free Intensive German Language Courses for exchange students from partner universities before the term starts and a large variety of German courses during the term. Living Expenses	Every student at WWU has to pay a social contribution fee for each semester, approximately 310 Euro. This fee contains the costs for the semester ticket that allows students to travel around the state of North Rhine-Westphalia. The living expenses for students in Münster run approximately 850 Euro per month, including accommodation, food and leisure activities.
