Language requirements	<p>Non-native English speakers must have a TOEFL score of 213 (computer-based), 550 (paper-based) or 79 (internet-based), or an IELTS (Academic Module) score of 6.0. We also accept a TOEIC score of 750 with a supporting letter* from home institution or a TOEFL ITP score of 550 with a supporting letter* from home institution.</p> <p>*the support letter can be issued by your office/faculty members certifying that your student is able to follow classes conducted in English</p>
