




Figure 1.1. Japan regions, prefecture and flag




Figure 1.4. Graph of Number of International Visitor to Japan

Japan: Age distribution from 2011 to 2021




Figure 1.6. Graph of Japan Ages Distribution

Japan: Population Ages 65 and Above (% Total Population)




Figure 1.7 Graph of Japan Population Ages 65 And Above




Figure 2.1. Graph of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) Japan & Indonesia




Figure 2.3. Picture of Japan World Class Ecosystem




Figure 2.4. Picture of Japan Social Security




Figure 2.5. Graph of Japan Gross National Income (Estimated)




Figure 3.2. Picture of Flow Process Career in Japan

Flowchart of Preparation to Work in Japan




Figure 4.1. Flowchart of preparation to work in Japan

- e. Accommodation During Training
- f. Uniform and Learning Kits
