Club activities during July 2011 – Mar 2012:

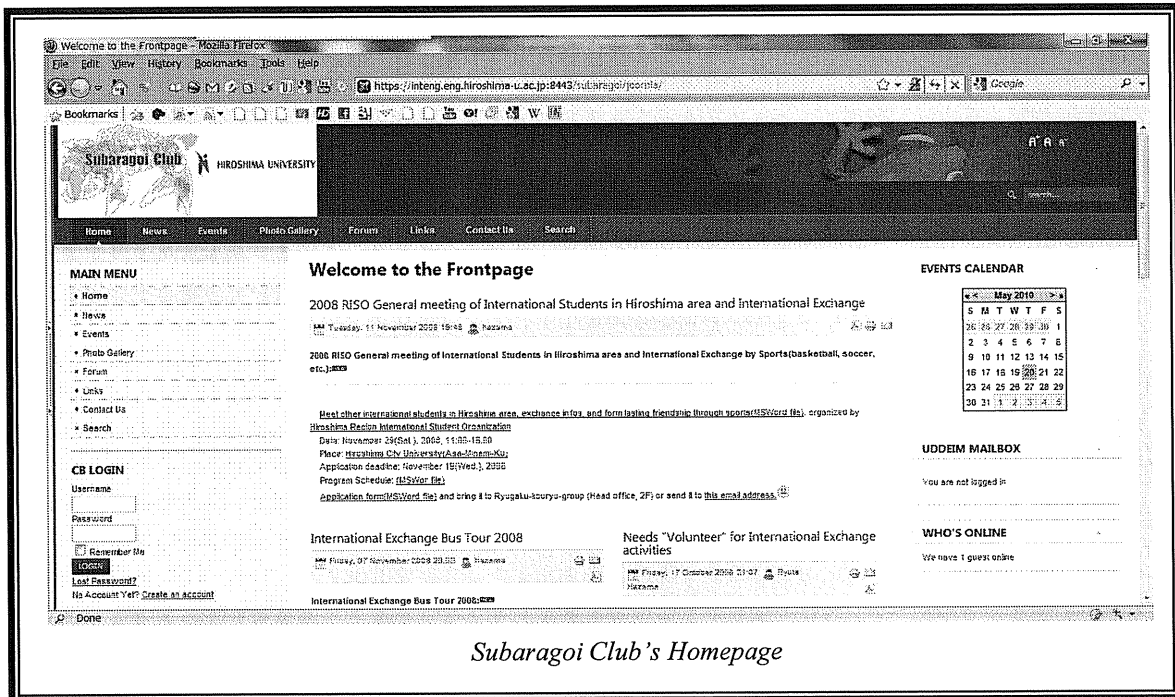
ACTIVITIES ON PRAY FOR JAPAN



3. Academic seminar during University festival: We would like to hold a seminar with the topic related to internationalization.
