Short description of the city	Located one hour away from Paris by TGV (High-speed train), Tours is at the heart of the "Région Centre-Val de Loire", in the Indre-et-Loire "département". The city itself is located at the confluence of the Loire and Cher rivers and spreads from the north of the Loire river (Tours Nord, Saint-Symphorien, Sainte-Radegonde) to the south of the Cher river (districts of Les Deux Lions, Les Fontaines, Parc Grandmont). On an imaginary line, it is located in the middle of France, right on the border between North and South and therefore has a mild climate. It is warm in summer (the weather is usually warm and relatively dry) and not too cold in winter (just a few days of snow), spring is mild and fall is balmy. Tours has a reputation for being one of the towns in France where the purest and most unblemished French is spoken. It is also the main town in a region renowned for its cultural, historical and gastronomic heritage. Many great authors in the French literature, many kings and many important characters spent some time here and each of them depicted this region or left his/her mark. The Loire Valley castles, vineyards, gastronomy, Balzac, Ronsard, Rabelais, Leonardo da Vinci, Saint Martin, will accompany the students arriving in our beautiful city.

Meal plan	All international exchange students have the right of eating at the CROUS university restaurants, using their student card
Insurance packages exchange students are required to purchase	All international exchange students must be covered from a medical point of view throughout the complete duration of their stay in France. In this sense, they have several health insurance options:  -European health insurance card (for European nationals) -global health insurance card (for UK nationals) -private insurance -insurance provided by the home university -French health insurance, free of charge and available for all international exchange students ( <a href="https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/">https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/</a> / https://www.ameli.fr/assure/droits-demarches/europe-international/protection-sociale-france/vous-venez-etudier-en-france) In France, it is mandatory to have your accommodation insured as well as being covered for any damage you may cause to others. Thus, you will have to take out a comprehensive home insurance policy called in French "Multirisques habitation" plus a civil liability insurance in order to build up your lease file. Both insurances can be included on the same policy.  Furthermore, landlords, whether private or institutional, will require a guarantor, i.e. a person (a relative or friend) or a legal entity (organization, association, etc) who commits in paying the rent should you fail to do so.
