Tutor System

- Tutors are academic staff who provide consultation and advise students regarding any concerns they may have about university life in order to help them have a meaningful and fulfilling campus life.
- Instructors of Introductory Seminar for First-Year Students serve as tutors for 1st-year students.
- "Tutor 1" and "Tutor 2" are registered in the Momiji system, and tutors for 1st-year students are academic staff registered as "Tutor 1".

For Safe Campus Life

- Physical and Mental Health
- Drinking alcohol (Drinking alcohol under the age of 20 is prohibited)
 "Chugging" is strictly forbidden. If you are forced to engage in chugging, firmly refuse to do so and leave. If a friend is forced to do so, do not pretend not to see it, but help him/her. Also, riding or driving a bicycle, motorcycle or car after drinking, as well as riding with a drunk driver, are crimes, and are subject to punishment under the Rules for Disciplinary Action for Students.
- Smoking (Smoking under the age of 20 is prohibited)
 Smoking is forbidden in all indoor and outdoor areas of the Hiroshima University campus.
- ➤ Drugs ⇒ Possession of cannabis or other drugs is a criminal act. Designer drugs can also cause fatalities.
- ▶ Mental health ⇒ The Health Service Center provides mental health consultations.
 A reservation is necessary.

Lost and Found Property

- Lost property reported to the Student Support Office as found property is stored by the Office for a certain period.
- Every year, many electronic dictionaries are reported as found property. If your name is indicated on the item, the Student Support Office can contact you. So be sure to put your name on your belongings.

Incidents and Accidents

➤ If you encounter a criminal incident or accident, contact the nearest police station. Also, please contact your tutor and the Student Support Office.

Traffic Accidents

- Car accidents ⇒ Accidents caused by lack of driving skills or not looking ahead carefully occur frequently.
- ➤ In case of an accident ⇒ If someone is injured, call an ambulance and contact the police.
- > 1st- and 2nd-year students are not allowed to commute to the university by car without a specific reason.

Bicycle Traffic Regulation Areas

➤ To prevent accident, DO NOT ride a bicycle in bicycle traffic regulation areas (including the area between the administrative building of the School of Integrated Arts and Sciences and the lecture building.

• Theft, Suspicious Individuals, etc.

- ➤ Theft ⇒ This happens in places like classrooms, gymnasiums or libraries. Use caution to guard against bicycle theft as well.
- Molestation, suspicious individuals, etc. ⇒ Walking alone during the night is dangerous. Do not let your guard down even at home.
- ▶ Bag snatching ⇒ Dark streets at night are particularly dangerous.

Education on Norms

- ➤ Observing social rules ⇒ Shoplifting is theft. "Unauthorized borrowing" of a bicycle whose owner is unknown is also a crime of embezzlement of lost articles.
- Misconduct in a semester-end examination, etc. ⇒ All grades for that semester will be "D (Failed)".
- ➤ Abuse of student discount ⇒ The student discount will no longer be available. A large surcharge will be imposed.

Computer-Related Trouble

- Take adequate care regarding the management of your password, and if you are involved in any trouble, immediately consult the Information Media Center, etc.
- The transmission of information via SNS should be done carefully with a high level of self-awareness and responsibility while paying sufficient attention to the management of personal information, etc.

Caution for Infectious Diseases

➤ If you are affected by an infectious disease such as COVID-19, influenza, measles, rubella, chickenpox or mumps, contact the Health Service Center.

Solicitation Activities by Destructive Cult Groups

- "Destructive cult" groups also exist within the university.
- > They speak to you as if they were members of a common student group of extracurricular activities. Refuse their solicitations if you feel suspicious about them.
- ➤ If you find yourself in trouble, go to the "All-Purpose Counseling Center" (the Student Plaza 3rd floor).

- > Scholarships from other scholarship organizations



Gakkensai Insurance

- The university pays the premiums for Gakkensai (personal accident insurance for students pursuing education and research), and all students are covered by this insurance until the end of their regular term of study.
- This insurance compensates students for injuries encountered during classes or school events, in university facilities, during extracurricular activities, while commuting to the university, or while moving between school facilities, according to the number of days of hospitalization or hospital visits required for the treatment.
