### 1. Degree Options

#### Hiroshima University (HU) – University of Graz (UG) Joint Programme



The programme covers theories and functions of public policy and their practical applications to development issues at both local and global perspectives. With completion of the programme, the students will obtain knowledge on public policy, management, and governance for poverty alleviation and economic development including SME (small and midsize enterprises) development and industrialization, human resource management and education, health and welfare, agricultural and rural development, environmental and climate policy, and urban and transportation policy.

The programme also emphasizes hands on and practical research experiences.

#### Hiroshima University (HU) – Leipzig University (LU) Joint Programme



The programme covers theories and functions of natural and ecological systems and the technologies that can use for development of the society. With completion of the programme, the students will obtain knowledge on Ecosystem Science, Environment Monitoring, Transportation & Urban Engineering, Energy Engineering, and Risk Management Technology.

The programme also emphasizes hands on and practical research experiences.

### 3. Finances & Fees

The final successful candidates whose evaluation results and grades are judged excellent will be exempted from the following application fee, admission fee, and tuition at HU. In addition, the HU JDP Scholarship (200,000JPY per semester) will be offered for up to 2 years.

#### Fees (amount before exemption)

-Application fee: 30,000JPY  
-Admission fee: 282,000JPY  
-Tuition: 267,900JPY per semester



#### Fees (Excellent candidates)

-Application fee: 0JPY  
-Admission fee: 0JPY  
-Tuition: 0JPY\*  
+ HU JDP Scholarship  
200,000 JPY financial support  
per semester for 2 years

\*Students pay tuition to the entrance university, but if their grades are judged excellent, their tuition will be waived for up to 2 years.
