



3. How to search for materials in the library

To search materials owned by Hiroshima University, you can use 2.2(3) OPAC Search on the library website.


[How to]

✘ If you want to make more detailed search, press “Advanced search”!




If there are too many results:



Call No : Where is the book on the shelves?






The label on the book



Topics: E-books for Extensive reading

Extensive reading is a reading method for learning a foreign language by reading a large amount of Graded Readers, whose text levels are divided, from easy books such as picture books. Please enjoy reading according to the following three principles:

1. **Don't use a dictionary**
2. **Skip over difficult words, phrases and passages.**
3. **When the going gets tough, quit the book and pick up another.**



Access to E-journals and E-books from off-campus

- Except for free (open) access content on the Internet, E-journals and E-books need to be accessed **on the campus network**.
- If you want to use them from **off-campus** such as at home, you need to use **VPN service** or **single sign-on**.
 - If you want to use the campus network on your laptop or smartphone, please connect to the Wi-Fi provided by the Information Media Center. (NOTE: "**HU-CUP**" can be used. "eduroam" is not available.)
 - Some databases may not be accessible from off-campus due to the publisher's terms of use. (e.g. Beck-online, UpToDate)

Use of VPN service #1


