This is also a meta-database that allows you to search academic information from around the world. It contains a wider range of journals than WoS . You can search more books here.



Arian Dylan, a 26-year-old native resident of Oaxaca, uses scalpels and knives to carve intricate abstract patterns and images into the surfaces of found books and magazines. A graduate of the National School of Painting, Sculpture and Engravings in Mexico City

A series called "Las virgin Buda" from 2009 features the Virgin of Guadalupe in the lotus position. These were executed on blank 13½-by-13-inch books, commissioned for the works, with thick, creamy pages. While lovely, and done with meticulous, laserlike cuts down to the Virgin's tiny fingernails, they lack the subtle irony and surprise of the found-publication works.

Another 2009 multipart piece is lit-

ing room. Simultaneously, motorized shutters opened to reveal fine white foam gushing down outside the windows, sprayed by a machine hidden on the roof, and absurdly mimicking snow. And yet Parnero insisted on presenting his cinematic thrills "n' spills right as a self-reflexive meditation on how an exhibition is constructed and perceived."

The films offered a cross-section of Parnero's career. No More Reality (1991) must serve as a manifesto
