3 Eligibility for Application

Non-Japanese who are currently not resident in Japan, and who meet, or expect to meet one of the following requirements by March 31, 2026, namely:

- (1) A parson who has graduated in Japan.
- (2) A parson who has received a Bachelor's degree from the National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation (NIAD-UE) based on paragraph 7, article 104 of the School Education Act (Act 26 of 1947. Hereafter referred to as the "Act").
- (3) A parson who has completed 16 years of formal schooling in a foreign country.
- (4) While resident in Japan, a parson who has taken distance courses provided by a school located in a different country to complete 16 years of formal schooling of said foreign country.
- (5) A parson who has studied at an educational institute in Japan designated by the educational policies of a foreign country as sufficiently equivalent to university courses of said foreign country (limited to foreign universities for which graduation requires 16 proper years of education) and is specifically recognized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (hereafter referred to as the "Minister")
- (6) A parson who has been conferred a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree through attending an overseas university or other overseas school (limited educational institutions certified by the relevant country's government or authoritative institution, or recognized as sufficiently equivalent by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology), and has graduated from a program requiring 3 or more years to complete (This includes correspondence courses offered by a foreign school in Japan, and

- completing the course at an educational institution that is properly recognized by the education system of said foreign country).
- (7) A parson who has completed a specialized course at a vocational school (limited to courses that have a duration of four years or more and meet other standards set by the Minister) recognized by the Minister within the period of the Minister's authorization.
- (8) A parson who has been designated by the Minister (including individuals who have graduated from universities as defined in the old University Directive, acts of incorporation and organizational directives of different government agencies, or laws governing independent administrative agencies).
- (9) A parson who has admitted to a graduate school based on the provisions of paragraph 2, article 102 of the Act, and were subsequently recognized by Hiroshima University Graduate School as having adequate academic abilities to study at the graduate school (individuals who skip grades to be enrolled in another graduate school, and subsequently wish to apply for the GSIAS).
- (10)A parson who is at least 22 years of age and recognized in an individual review of admission eligibility carried out by the Hiroshima University Graduate School, as having academic abilities equal to or greater than a university graduate.
- (11)A parson who has studied at university for at least 3 years (including those designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) and have earned high mark credits recognized by the Hiroshima University Graduate School.

4 Notes

- (1) Please discuss the substance of your research with the professor under whom you wish to study before applying. Preliminary consultations have no impact on selection.

- (2) Hiroshima University has established the university's Rules on Security Export Control in accordance with the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act, and conducts strict examinations for acceptance of international students, etc. Therefore, please be advised that International applicants may be unable to receive their desired education or conduct their desired research due to the restriction by the above regulations.

5 Preliminary Evaluation

A person who apply under Eligibility for application (9) - (11) must contact Support office for the fields of Integrated Arts and Sciences (Contact for inquiry Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences), and submit the specified documents by October 15, 2025 (Wed).

6 Application Procedure

1. Submission Procedure

All applicants must obtain consent from their prospective supervisor in advance to apply for the Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences. After that, applicants are required to apply using "online application system", and send the necessary documents. (Partially online application hereinafter referred to as "online application")

Online Application

- 1) Enter your personal information.
- 2) Pay the application fee, 30,000 yen.
- 3) All application documents must be either sent by mail or delivered in person.

Note: Online application, entering necessary information on the website and paying the application fee, is the initial registration process, and doesn't mean the completion of the application procedure. The application procedure wouldn't be completed without either sending or delivering in person all the necessary application documents by the due date. Be sure to send or bring in person all the necessary application documents to the support office (the aforementioned address). Application documents must arrive within the specified period at

the support office. Fully paper-based application without registering online application cannot be accepted in this graduate school.

Step 3: Enter the Account Number (Only for those who are exempt from the Application fee). Further, enter the alphanumeric code (consisting of 8 or more characters) which you received from the Graduate School concerned.

Step 4: Enter your application data into the online application system

Follow the instruction on the screen and enter your name, address, etc.

Step 5: Upload your photograph.

Follow the instruction on the screen to upload the digital data of your photograph (File format: JPEG). It is not allowed to submit the photograph via mail.

* The uploaded photo, which will be used for identification at the examination, will be also used for your student ID card after enrollment. Therefore, please upload an appropriate photo for use after enrollment as well.

Once uploaded, your photo will not be allowed to be replaced.

A fee of JPY 1,000 will be charged for changing the content of your student ID card (photo and your name) after enrollment.

Step 6: Pay of application fee (JPY 30,000 yen)

The Master's Degree Program requires international students to reach a satisfactory level of proficiency in Japanese language or English language since almost all classes are held in Japanese or English.

3. Advance Consultation for Reasonable Accommodation in Studying

Applicants with physical disabilities, etc. who require accommodations in studying, must submit an application form for advance consultation (no prescribed form), containing the following information:

7 Student Selection Method (Academic Examinations)

Selection is based upon a comprehensive evaluation of transcripts, research proposal and other submitted documents. Also, we can conduct an oral examination over the Internet. Details of the oral examination will be announced individually by mail to the applicants.

8 Announcement of Results

Announcement of admission is by email on December 19, 2025 (Fri) 12:00 (JST). Written notice is sent to all successful applicants. No telephone inquiries.

9 Admission Procedure

Admission fee: 282,000 yen

Tuition fee (annual): 535,800 yen (267,900 yen for the first semester)

Notes: 1) The admission fee will not be refunded, without exception.

- 2) Applicants will be required to pay the new tuition fee if the fee is revised. In addition, the amount of the fees listed above is as of April 2025.
- 3) The Student Support Office will separately inform you regarding details such as the amount of the payment and the specific payment method during the designated period in Early March 2026.
- 4) Hiroshima University has a system of half or total exemption of admission or tuition fees for those with difficulties in paying admission or tuition fees due to economic reasons (admission fees may either be exempted or deferred). Those who would like a payment exemption or deferment should apply for this system. Applicants are ranked according to need based on household income, and waivers are granted accordingly within the budget so that, depending on necessity, the applicants may receive a waiver for all or half the tuition fees or no waiver at all.

10 Personal information acquired through this application
