AI-Era Report Writing Support! (The Writing Center)

Are you writing reports and papers or need help? Many people use AI nowadays. Hiroshima University has a Writing Center (WRC) where tutors support everyone's academic writing. This month, we interviewed two WRC tutors! We will introduce practical episodes while exploring questions like "Can AI write papers for you?" and "How does the WRC differ?"

How does a consultation proceed?

Consultations progress in alignment with each student (1). While listening to your assignment, we help you notice areas for improvement through dialogue and support you in revising Ms. Indah Islami your writing. Even a single session can offer new insights. If you come repeatedly, we can provide more detailed advice tailored to your writing style(2).

Do students come for consultations after using AI?





- (1) Tutors have various consultation styles. Some start with icebreakers.
- (2) Some students have returned with significantly improved writing after taking notes from their first consultation.
- (3) Some students bring drafts written entirely by AI or combine their own writing with AI feedback.
- (4) Also, be cautious when asking questions to AI, as your input may be collected.

Yes⁽³⁾. AI can reflect your intentions, but reports are evaluated by others. WRC tutors help revise your writing to ensure clarity for any reader. AI text may look smooth but can lack depth or coherence. During sessions, tutors may notice when certain phrases don't sound like your own words—and that's an important moment for reflection.



How should I use AI and WRC support effectively?



While AI is convenient for information gathering, errors do occur, so accuracy verification is necessary. (4). At WRC, we think together with students about what they want to communicate through dialogue. Learning the writing process is part of the experience. We help students gradually organize their thoughts and express them in their own words. Ultimately, students are responsible for their writing.

Recommended books selected during their training are now on display on the 2nd floor of the West Library. Come take a look!




