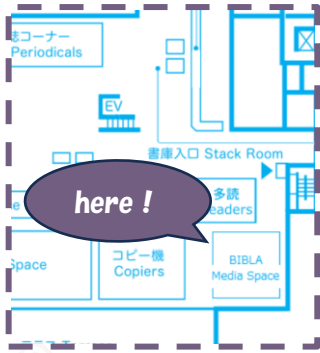

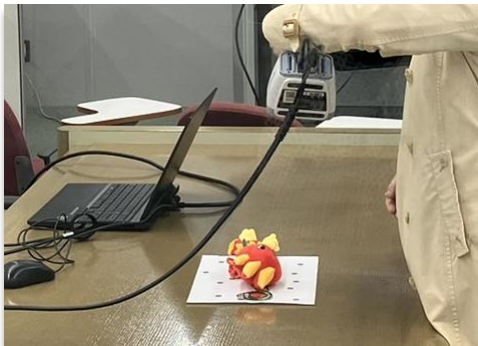
3D Scanner
