

CAMPUS OF ALAVA: centers located in Vitoria-Gasteiz

Faculty of Arts

- Academic requirements:
 - Incoming students cannot do the Final Degree Project at this faculty.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B1 level of Spanish and English recommended.

Faculty of Pharmacy:

- Academic requirements:
 - Professional hospital practice: exchange students do not have access to the practice held in hospitals. Places available in the nutrition field and pharmacy in hospitals are very few and are highly demanded by our students. Due to this, there is no option to offer them to incoming students.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - Undergraduate and postgraduate students: B1 level of Spanish and English recommended.
 - Tutored or supervised practice: C1 level of Spanish mandatory.

Faculty of Labour Relations and Social Work, Social Work headquarter

- Academic requirements:
 - Incoming exchange students cannot take part in the mandatory practice (practicum), nor do the Final Degree Project at this faculty.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B1 level of Spanish and English recommended.

Faculty of Engineering at Vitoria-Gasteiz:

- Academic requirements:
 - None to date.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - Spanish intermediate level to follow the classes.

Faculty of Economics and Business, Vitoria-Gasteiz headquarter

- Academic requirements:
 - It is possible to follow subjects not only from the Faculty of Economics and Business at Vitoria-Gasteiz, but also of other faculties located at the Campus of Alava whose multidisciplinary content can be suitable for their study plan. It is not possible to follow subjects from other Faculty of Economics and Business' headquarters located at other campuses (Bilbao-Sarriko, Bilbao-Elkano or Donostia/San Sebastián) due to the distance between campuses.
 - Incoming students cannot do the Final Degree Project at this faculty.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B2 level of English and B1 level of Spanish mandatory. Regarding the required level of Spanish, it is more flexible for students coming from Countries with native romanic languages: french, italian, portuguese...
Regarding the level of English, at Vitoria-Gasteiz they are more flexible comparing to the other headquarters. Nevertheless, a certain level certificate might be required anyway.

Faculty of Education and Sport

- Academic requirements:
 - Students should check well the tuition language of the subjects offered at this faculty. In the Education field, the Degree in Pre-School Education is only taught in Basque. This means that will not be available for incoming students that do not know this language.
In the Degree of Primary Education, there is a trilingual line available (Spanish, English and Basque) in which a 30 credit learning agreement could be made with subjects taught in Spanish/English (there is, in fact, an specific plan to facilitate this to the incoming students both in the first and second semesters. Spanish-speaking students could complement that plan with other subjects taught in Spanish).
In the Degree of Physical Activity Sciences and Sport, all subjects are taught in Spanish and Basque.
 - Incoming students cannot do the Final Degree Project at this faculty.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B2 level of Spanish recommended for the Degree in Physical Activity Sciences and Sport. B2 level of Spanish and/or English recommended also for the Education Degrees.
