

CAMPUS OF GIPUZKOA: centers located in Donostia/San Sebastián

Faculty of Economics and Business, Donostia/San Sebastian headquarters

- Academic requirements:
 - It is not possible to follow subjects from other Faculty of Economics and Business' headquarters located at other campuses (Bilbao-Sarriko, Bilbao-Elkano or Donostia/San Sebastián) due to the distance between campuses.
 - There can be problems of places in the optional classes/subjects due to their high demand and the limited number of spots available.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B2 level of English and B1 level of Spanish mandatory. Even if this headquarter is more flexible with this requirement, a certain certificate stating students' level might be required.

Higher Technical School of Architecture

- Academic requirements:
 - If students chose optional classes/subjects, they must take into account that these are subject to *numerus clausus* or to have a certain number of students registered to be offered. Staff at the center cannot guarantee a place in these subjects until students arrive to the center in person and complete their registration (even if the learning agreement is signed/approved) as it is possible that the places available are fully completed with their own students, or, directly, do not have enough students registered to be able to open a group and be offered.
 - Incoming exchange students are not allowed to follow subjects of the master. Postgraduate students will not be admitted in this center. Only undergraduate exchange students will be accepted in this center.
 - Incoming students are not allowed to make the Final Degree Project during their stay.
 - In general agreements, only two students per semester will be admitted.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - A2 level of Spanish and B1 level of English recommended.

Faculty of Engineering Gipuzkoa, Donostia/San Sebastian headquarters

- Academic requirements:
 - None to date.

 - B2 level of Spanish and/or English recommended.

Faculty of Engineering Gipuzkoa, Eibar headquarter

- Academic requirements:
 - None to date.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B2 level of Spanish and/or English recommended.

Faculty of Education, Philosophy and Anthropology

- Academic requirements:
 - Visiting students may request to do work experience as part of the subjects for the Practicum, except for the degree in Pre-Primary Education. The practicum offer in the Social Anthropology, Pre-primary Education, Primary Education and Pedagogy degrees will be limited and it will not be possible to guarantee a placement in advance. For this reason the request will need to be made three months in advance and an adequate language level will need to be accredited. The Final Degree Project (FDP) will not be included in the academic agreement.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - Before applying, we recommend that you check the language offer of the subjects. Degrees in Philosophy, Social Anthropology, Social Education and Pedagogy are offered in Spanish and Basque. Most of the subjects in Pre-Primary Education and Primary Education are offered in Basque
 - A B2 language level will need to be accredited to be able to enrol for the Minor subjects that have a foreign language component. It is important to bear in mind that the subjects are year-long ones.

Faculty of Informatics

- Academic requirements:
 - Incoming students are recommended to take at least 18 credits per semester.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B2 level of Spanish and/or English recommended.

Faculty of Chemistry

- Academic requirements:
 - None to date.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B2 level of Spanish and/or English recommended.

Faculty of Psychology

- Academic requirements:
 - Incoming students will not be able to take part in external practices, nor make the Final Degree Project in this faculty.
 - Regarding the optional classes/subjects, students should take into account that they have a specific and limited number of places. There are highly demanded subjects that are covered very quickly. Incoming students that add these subjects to their learning agreements risk to make changes at their arrival if the quota in these subjects is full and there are no more places available. Some of these subjects might also be given/taught in English. If students have a B2 level of English, if there are places available, they could follow these optional classes/subjects in this language.
- Linguistic requirements:
 - B2 level of English recommended for subjects taught in this language.
 - B2 level of Spanish mandatory for subjects taught in this language.
