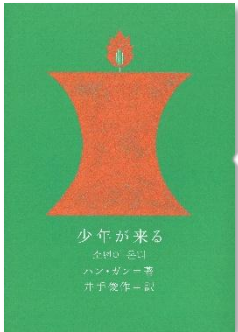

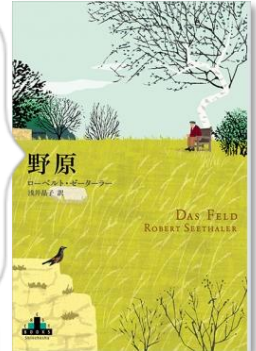

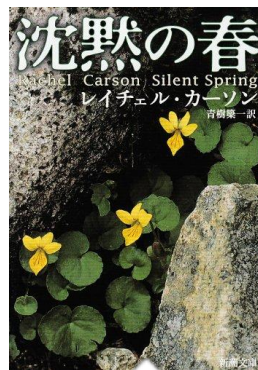

Hiroshima University Institutional Repository has moved to a new site due to system migration.

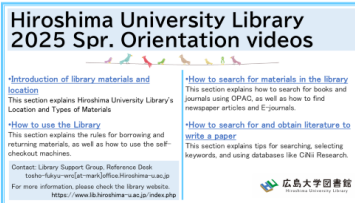

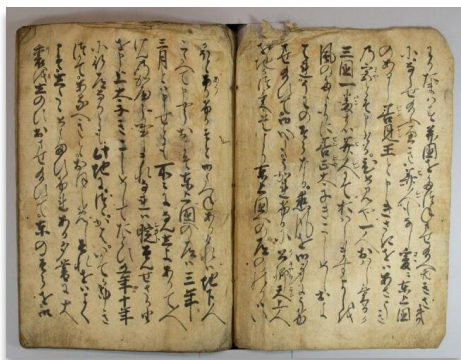

## 善正太子物語 (Zensho Taishi Monogatari)

(Stored in the Rare Manuscripts Room)

This is a manuscript written in 1538 during the Muromachi period. Although the book is titled "Zenjo Taishi Monogatari" (Tales of Zenjo Taishi), the actual title of the book is unknown, as there is no indication of the title.

The content of this is related to Buddhism and will be a good opportunity to become familiar with Japanese culture.
