Seminar on "Research and Education for Designing A Low Carbon World" as an event of the 4th Home Coming Day

国際協力研究科 (IDEC) は第4回ホームカミングデー企画として「低炭素社会を設計する教育研究セミナー」を、平成22年11月6日に IDEC 大会議室で開催した。参加者は退職教員、修了生、教職員、学生を含め合計55名であった。講演者は元広島大学教員の日下部治教授(現東京工業大学)、現 IDEC 教員の金子慎治教授、IDEC 修了生の東香織氏(現国際協力機構)の3名であった。低炭素社会を共通のテーマに、研究科の過去・現在・将来の中心人物から話題提供をいただく企画であった。

池田研究科長の挨拶に続いて、まず1994年当時、IDEC の創設にご尽力いただいた日下部教授が招待講演「回顧と期待」を行った。講演では、IDEC 設立時の背景と研究科への期待、科学技術の発展と国際協力の段階、今後の環境対策の展望について、客観的な分析に基づいた明察をいただいた。続いて、IDEC の現役教員を代表して開発政策講座の金子教授が、「低炭素社会設計する国際人材育成」と題して、現在 IDEC が実施している国際環境リーダー育成プログラムの紹介と、国際環境協力の実践的研究の報告を行った。さらに、修了生を代表して JICA 経済基盤開発部の東氏が「低炭素社会に向けた国際協力」と題して、JICA が行っている事業紹介を通じて地球温暖化に関する国際協力の基本コンセプトの紹介を行った。

最後に、フロアーからの質疑応答を行う中で、今後のIDEC の学際的教育研究の進むべき方向性について活発な意見交換がなされた。とりわけ IDEC 設立の1994年から16年が経過し、世代交替が進んだ IDEC にとって、日下部教授から提案いただいた研究科の将来ビジョンは「原点回帰」を再考する鮮明なメッセージとなった。

IDEC organized the seminar on "Research and Education for Designing A Low Carbon World" as an event of the 4th Home Coming Day on November 6, 2010 at the Large

Conference room of IDEC. The number of participants counted totally 55 including the professors emeriti, the alumni of IDEC, the former and current professors and staff members, and IDEC students. The speakers consisted of three key figures in the past, at present and in the future of IDEC: Professor Osamu Kusakabe (Tokyo Institute of Technology and the former professor of Hiroshima Univ.), Professor Shinji Kaneko (a current professor of IDEC) and Ms. Kaori Higashi (JICA and an alumna of IDEC). The international cooperation toward a low carbon world was a topic common to all of them.

After the opening address by Prof. Ikeda, the dean of IDEC, Prof. Kusakabe who is a contributor of IDEC establishment in 1994 gave us the invited lecture entitled "Reminiscence and expectation". He discerned based on his objective analysis in terms of its background and expectation of IDEC, the development of science and technology and stages of international cooperation, and the perspective upon environmental policies. Then on behalf of the present IDEC professors, Prof. Kaneko from the development policy department introduced the ongoing "Global environmental leaders education program for designing a low-carbon society" at IDEC and he also reported his empirical and practical studies. Furthermore Ms. Higashi of the department of economic infrastructure development, JICA as the representative of IDEC alumni presented their activities and a basic concept of international cooperation on global warming issues.

At the final session joined by the audiences, there were various and insightful discussions about our future course of interdisciplinary education and research in IDEC. Especially, some suggestions concerning the future vision of IDEC left by Prof. Kusakabe were distinct messages and incentives for the new generation of IDEC to reconsider "a revolution" 16 years after its foundation in 1994.

Program in Bangladesh Has Been Launched!

2004年10月に広島大学が株式会社パデコと共同受託した JICA プロジェクト「バングラデシュ国小学校理数科教育 強化計画」フェーズ1は、2010年3月に終了した。その最大 の成果は、教育パッケージを開発したことと教育の質に対する意識を高めたことである。教育パッケージは、バングラデシュの算数と理科において、比較的難しいトピックに 関して授業案や教材、評価シートをひとまとめにし、具体 的に授業改善のためのヒントを提供しようというものである。国立初等教育アカデミー(NAPE)の専門官や協力校 教員と共に開発した。2007年11月には、11の援助機関が参加する初等教育サブセクタープログラム(PEDPII)の中でその成果が認められ、全体資金(プールファンド)の一部を用いて全国の小学校や教員研修関係施設に配布された。

2010年11月より再始動したフェーズ2では、この教育パッケージを効果的に使用し、学校で授業が改善されることを目指して活動する予定である。そのため全国に57校ある初等教員養成校を9つのクラスターに分けて、各初等教員養成校はその地域の教員支援ネットワークの中心として教員研修を実施したり、既存の現職教員研修の改善案を提案した

りする。また教育パッケージの開発の実績より、国レベルでのカリキュラム開発に対する支援も求められている。今後、留学生や研修員の受け入れ、共同研究の実施などを通して、大学が持つ教育研究機能を最大限に活用し、より効果の上がる国際協力プロジェクトを行っていきたいと思う。

JICA's technical cooperation "Strengthening Primary Teacher Training on Science and Mathematics in Bangladesh" has implemented jointly by IDEC, Hiroshima University and PADECO Co., Ltd. since October 2004. The first phase of this project was completed in March 2010. The best outcomes of the project are to have developed Teaching Packages (TPs) and to have raised awareness of the quality of education. TP means a compilation of lesson plans, teaching-learning materials, and evaluation sheets on the topics of math and science that teachers find difficult to teach. They are to provide teachers with some hints for lesson improvement. We developed these TPs together with specialists of NAPE (National Academy for Primary Education) as well as FTS (Field Testing School) teachers. Since TPs have received high recognition in November 2007 in the framework of sub-sector program (PEDP-II) supported by 11 development partners, TPs were disseminated to the government primary schools and those teacher training institutes across the country, by some of the whole program funds (pool funds).

In the second phase which has restarted in November 2010, we plan to work for effective utilization of TPs and improvement of the lesson. Therefore we will be involved in developing the model of teacher support network and conducting various type of teacher training by grouping 57 Primary Teacher Training Institutes (PTIs) throughout the country into 9 clusters. Also we are requested to support revision of curriculum at the nation level based on experience in TP development. In the future making the best use of university's educational and research functions, we would like to have international cooperation projects more effectively through accepting international students and researchers, and implementing joint research

「低炭素社会を設計する国際環境リーダー育成 (GELs)」 プログラムでは、インドネシア・ボゴール農業大学(IPB) との共催で、2010年度サマーコース「低炭素社会における 発展:気候変動政策計画・実施のための参加型アプローチ」 を、2010年8月5~13日 に ボゴール 農業大学・SEAMEO BIOTROP キャンパスで開催しました。前年に引き続き第2 回目の開催となる今回のサマーコースでは、途上国におけ る気候変動に対処するための効果的なツールである「参加 型アプローチ」と、その適用可能なケースとしての「森林 管理」と「都市における気候変動政策の計画・実施」を テーマに選びました。GELs 学生をはじめとして、IDEC 修 了生、IPB 学生、インドネシア政府関係者ら総勢40名(11 カ国)の参加がありました。サマーコース参加者は、 IDEC、IPB 教員および様々な国際機関や政府機関より招聘 した専門家による講義を受講し学術的、実務的知見を身に つけた上で、グループワークとしてインドネシアモデル地 域を対象としたケーススタディを実施することによって、 「参加型アプローチ」についての応用力向上を図りました。 講義、グループワークを通して活発な質疑応答や議論が繰 り広げられ、参加者からは非常に有意義なサマーコースと の評価がありました。また、それぞれのケーススタディは、 各グループによってインドネシアのケースに特化した参加 型アプローチのガイドラインとしてまとめられており、 IDEC ジャーナル特集号への掲載が予定されています。

The Global Environmental Leaders Education Program for Designing a Low-Carbon World (GELs program) were conducted the second summer course 2010 entitled "DEVELOPMENT WITHIN A LOW CARBON WORLD: Participatory Approaches in Planning and Implementing Climate Change Policies", in cllaboration with Master of Science in Information Technology for Natural Resources Management (M.Sc. in IT for NRM), Bogor Agricultural University (IPB) at SEAMEO BIOTROP Campus, IPB, Indonesia from August 5 to 13, 2010. This summer course focused on the forestry management and planning and implementation of climate policies for cities as cases for the potential application of participatory approaches (PAs), which are known as an effective tool in coping with the challenges of climate change in developing countries. There were forty participants including IDEC students in the GELs program, IDEC alumni, IPB

students and Indonesia's government officers. These participants were satisfied with this summer course, as the topic is timely and the lectures were effective and relevant for learning PAs. The country-specific guidelines on PAs for Indonesia case of forestry management and climate change policies for cities formulated by the participants during group works will be published as a special issue of IDEC Journal.

マハラジャン研究室は、発展途上国の諸問題について農村 経済学、地域研究、国際協力の観点から研究を行うダブー (プラットフォーム)である。研究のモットーは『人類のため、社会のため、地球のため』としている。それを達成するため、「多様性の中から普遍性」をみいだすように努めている。学生が取り上げる研究テーマ一貧困、食糧確保、環境、土地、持続的発展、地域平和等の各問題―には現地調査による実証的研究が中心だが、研究室では事例研究に止まらぬよう訓練し、国際的感覚をもって高度な判断できる人材を養成することを目的としている。現在、インド、インドネシア、ガーナ、カンボジア、キルギス、中国、日本、ネパール、ボッワナの学生が各国の最重要な課題について研究を行っている。上記テーマにおけるコミュニティの役割は最近各学生らが取り上げる中心的研究課題である。

卒業生は国際食糧農業機構や国際協力機構のような国際 機関、大学、非政府機関などに勤めている。彼らは自分らの 経験を後輩らと共有するため、研究室が主催する「フォーラ ム開発と文化変容」研究会で発表したりする。

また、昼休憩のスポーツやゼミ後の飲み会が研究室の親睦 の場となっている。



Diversity is the identity of Maharjan Seminar, which provides daboo (platform) for the students to share knowledge on diverse issues of developing countries, such as, poverty, food security, sustainable development, agricultural and rural development, land, environment and reproductive health and issues of regional peace, through the perspectives of Rural Economics, Regional Studies and International Cooperation. The focal point of the research is, "for the mankind, for the society, for the mother earth", and look for universality among the diversity of different research work. Role of community in such research is one of the important issues being researched by the students in the seminar. Research of each student is based on the preliminary findings from field studies, discussed in the international context. This would help students to understand the local problems more vividly and provide them unique opportunity to broaden their knowledge of diverse issues from the international perspectives. Currently there are students from Botswana, Cambodia, China, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kyrgyzstan, and Nepal.

Japanese government set a target to cut 25% of GHG (Greenhouse Gas) by 2020 and 80% by 2050. Dr. Fujino is leading to developing Japan Low-Carbon Society (LCS) scenarios that reduce GHG emissions around 60-80% by 2050 in Japan and structuring "a dozen actions" to realize technical reduction options. He is one of modelers to provide simulation results to achieve 25% GHG emissions reduction by 2020 compared as 1990 level for the Japanese government. He explained the latest information on Japanese LCS scenarios and policies and its implementation on Asian LCS scenarios.

Mr Matthew Beck is a lecturer in University of Sydney, Australia. He visited IDEC as a young researcher under the GELs program. In this seminar, he presented an empirical study of the emission charging policy in transport sector. A new type of state preference survey was conducted via the Internet to capture people's preferences for choosing different types of vehicles under different charging scenarios, where a so-called d-efficient design was adopted to reflect the influence of nonorthogonal features related to the trade-offs among factors affecting vehicle type choice behavior (e.g., purchase price, fuel price, engine capacity, seating capacity, fuel efficiency). Furthermore, a generalized mixed logit model was employed to capture the influence of heterogeneity existing in the choice of vehicle type. Such innovative approaches (both survey and modeling methods) could provide more useful insights into the emission charging design, and they could be applicable to other aspects related to low-carbon urban and transportation policies in both developed and developing countries.

概要 Summary

Prof. Hsu is famous for the developer of the theory of beach stabilization using zeta-bayed. Bayed beaches in static equilibrium are the only physiographic features that could remain stable without sediment supply in a persistent swell environment. With a continuing trend of erosion to sandy beaches worldwide, a conservative and prudent hypothesis is to consider the scenario of vanishing supply to a beach in the future, for which a parabolic bay shape equation is recommended for devising a countermeasures to mitigate erosive condition. This talk introduced the applicability the equation to a wide range of selected examples of bayed beaches in natural and man-made condition.

Climate change and development of soil respiration measuring method in various ecosystems

日時 Date: December 8, 2010

Two subtitles about ecosystem study were presented in this seminar.

- 1. To study the effect of global warming on the growth of plants and plant populations throughout their life cycle under a field-like condition, we constructed a Temperature Gradient Chamber (TGC) and CO₂-Temperature gradient Chamber (CTGC). Also, to evaluate the effects of elevated temperature and CO₂ on the annual C3 and C4 species, *Chenopodium album* (C3) and *Setaria viridis* (C4) were grown in TGE and CTGC.
- 2. The function of ecosystem would be changed by change of dominant species in community due to climate change. To evaluate change of carbon flux in ecosystem, we developed an automatic open/closing chamber system (AOCC) based on open-flow method and it can use for four seasons even in snowpeak surface. The AOCC well reflected that the marked seasonal and daily soil respiration variations were strongly related to soil temperature. (Coordinator: Kensuke Kawamura)
