Application Guidelines for International Students Sponsored by the Vietnamese Government

Subject to terms and conditions as provided below, Hiroshima University accepts international students that the Vietnam International Education Development of the Ministry of Education (VIED-MOET) sponsors.

2. Admission Periods

October or April

3. Who can apply / Enrollment Period

- Students who wish to enter Hiroshima University's doctoral programs for the purpose of obtaining a doctoral degree.
- The period of study is 3 years for all doctoral programs except for the Graduate School of Biomedical and Health Sciences where 4-year doctoral programs are offered

4. Eligibility

- · Students recommended by VIED-MOET
- · Students who have language proficiency deemed sufficient to receive education and

research guidance at Hiroshima University

· Students who obtain a supervisor's approval for application

5. Tuition and other fees

Successful applicants will be exempted from examination, admission, and tuition fees. Note that the waiver period for doctoral students will be limited to the standard period required to complete the program. In case of program extension, students are responsible to pay the tuition fees.

6. Application Documents

- ①Application for admission
- ②Letter of Nomination issued by VIED-MOET
- 30ther documents required by the graduate school

7. Time and method of application

- (1) Time of application is determined by each graduate school
- (2) Method of application

Application documents mentioned in Section6 should be sent to the office of the graduate school using a postal service(ex. EMS) or other delivery means that provides tracking.

8. Selection and announcement of successful applicants

Each graduate school and Hiroshima University will assess applications according to its own selection criteria. The applicant and VIED-MOET, respectively, will be notified of the first selection result. Applicants who pass the final selection by VIED-MOET will submit the certificate issued by VIED-MOET.

9. Admission Procedures

Documents required for admission procedures (including the Certificate of Eligibility an immigration document required to obtain college student visa) will be sent to successful applicants, who must then carry out the procedures by the date designated by each graduate school.

10. Notes

- (1) All applicants are required to find their prospective academic advisors before submitting their application documents for admission to HU.
- (2) Incomplete applications may not be accepted.
- (3) Application documents will not be returned and may not be replaced or modified after submission.
- (4) For more information on the application, please contact the graduate school that you hope to enter.
- (5) Personal information(name, date of birth, gender, etc) recorded on application forms will be used in the selection of entrants, notification of passing or entrance exams and also entrance procedures. Once successful applicants have entered the university, the university will manage the data for use in matters relating to student support. This data will not be used for any other purpose or be seen by anyone except staff of this

university. However, after an agreement has been made regarding the appropriate use of personal information, there may be cases whereby related business is entrusted to companies outside the university for purposes of computer management.
