As witnessed from the history of nuclear energy development, nuclear accident may cause substantial physical and social damages. The recovery from the nuclear disaster requires great efforts from society with regard to long-term decontamination of the environment, issues of public health, and the rehabilitation of economic and social activities. An effective leadership and trust among stakeholders are believed crucial for achieving the successful recovery.

This symposium aims to elucidate the role of leadership in strengthening trust with various stakeholders by determining appropriate strategies for enhancing communication and cooperation among them for the effective disaster recovery, particularly radiation disaster. The outcomes of these discussions will contribute toward bringing new insights into post-Fukushima nuclear accident rehabilitation.
