Summary:

Japan has played important role in development activities in Cambodia as top bilateral donor since 1992. Several factors will affect to Japanese ODA's positioning to Cambodia.

Active emerging donors such as China and Korea are one of external factors.

Internal factors are originated from Japan's ODA. After explain about several factors, presentation will try to indicate how Japan's ODA especially technical cooperation can be improved, from the view of Japan's ODA process from project/program/policy formulation, those implementation, as well as those monitoring and evaluation.
