7. Qualifications

Applicants must satisfy all of the following requirements:

- 1) Major in the field of Economics with a specialization of Econometrics and/or its application
- 2) Excellent academic activities and achievements in Econometrics or related field at least one A- or two B+ journal publication(s). Journal ranking is according to either IDEC journal list or Economics journal list of Development Policy Department of IDEC.
- 3) Ph.D.
- 4) Being able to teach and supervise effectively in English

8. Application materials required

- ii) Papers presented at international conferences and symposiums
- iii) Other papers (except i) and ii))
- iv) Books
- v) Research funds obtained
- vi) Others (project reports, database, patents, etc.)

2) PDFs of the reprints or copies of your main publications (maximum three out of the above)

3) Personal statement (including research plan, aspirations for education and international contribution and syllabus of the course in charge) or a reference letter from the persons having remarkable achievements in the field.
