

## Scholarship System for International Students

The following are the main type of scholarships that international students can receive. The numbers of scholarships available are limited; we urge you to plan your finances well in advance of coming to Japan.

### [Hiroshima University's Unique Scholarship Programs]

Hiroshima University offers some special scholarship programs for international students.

#### International Students Supporters' Club Scholarship

was established by donations from faculty members and extramural contributors. The university will select the grantee by inner selection in accordance with the individual application.

##### <Contents of Awards>

Monthly Stipend: 30,000 yen

Duration: 6 months

Number of Grantees: 20 students  
(The performance of 2016)

#### Excellent Student Scholarship Program

is a unique scholarship program of Hiroshima University that recognizes outstanding graduate students in academic record and activities.

##### <Contents of Awards>

Certificate of Commendation

Souvenir Gift

Tuition Exemption (full amount) for One Semester

#### Prior to Admission Scholarship Program (HU-PASP)

The university will select the grantees from students who enrolled by pre-arrival admission system\*.

##### <Contents of Awards>

Monthly Stipend: 50,000 yen

Grant: Tuition Exemption for 1 Year

Duration: 1 year

Number of Grantees: 8 students

\* Examination system in which the entrance exam can be taken without coming to Japan

### [Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarships]

There are two different categories for the Japanese Government Scholarship: recommendation by Japanese Embassy; or recommendation by University.

#### Recommendation by Japanese Embassy

On behalf of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), Japanese Embassies abroad make announcements regarding applications for MEXT scholarships. They also conduct the preliminary screening of applicants based on documents received, written tests, and interviews. On the basis of recommendations by Japanese embassies, MEXT makes the final selection of scholarship recipients. For details, please check with your nearest Japanese Embassy.

#### Recommendation by University

##### Students Wishing to Enter the University from Abroad:

The University recommends to MEXT a certain number of exceptional graduate students from universities abroad with which the University has an official student exchange agreement. MEXT makes the final selection.

### [Scholarships from Foundations]

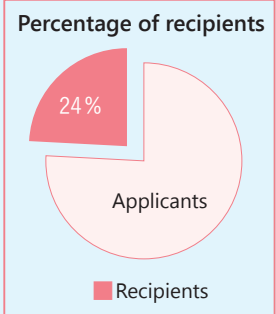
Scholarships from approximately 40 private foundations are available. Approximately 250 students receive these kinds of scholarships each year.

These scholarships are available only for the self-funded students who are enrolled in Hiroshima University and are not applicable for students who are abroad or have not yet been admitted.

Students who wish to apply for scholarships will be required to make an application in accordance with the application guide of each foundation. Please visit the following website for more details.

#### Outline of Application for Private Foundation Scholarships

Eligibility	Resident Status "Student". Other eligibilities differ depending on foundations.
Duration	For one year ~ Regular period of years to complete a course
Monthly Amount	20,000 yen ~ 180,000 yen
Period of Applications	Start from July in previous year ~ by June of recipient year
