

Required Admission Expenses

International students must pay the following application, admission, and tuition charges before entering the University: (as of April 2017)

Status	Application Fee	Admission	Tuition
Undergraduate Student	¥17,000	¥282,000	¥535,800 (per year)
Graduate Student	Master's Program	¥30,000	¥282,000
	Doctoral Program	¥30,000	¥282,000
Research Student (Non-Degree)*	¥ 9,800	¥ 84,600	[Research Fees] ¥29,700 (per month)

(If tuition is revised while you are a student, you will pay tuition after the revision.)

*Research fees are to be paid every 6 months. Admission as a research student will be canceled if a student doesn't pay their research fees within 3 months of admission.

Admission Fee Exemption/Deferment

To support those who find it difficult to pay admission fees due to special circumstances, Hiroshima University has programs in place to exempt enrollment fees, or extend their payment deadline by a certain length of time. (Research students are ineligible.)

Tuition Fee Exemption

Hiroshima University has a system in which the tuition fee can be waived completely, or be reduced to half price in order to assist students with financial difficulties and would thus be unable to pay tuition fees. (Research students are ineligible.)

The average monthly living expenses, including school expenses of international students are as follows:

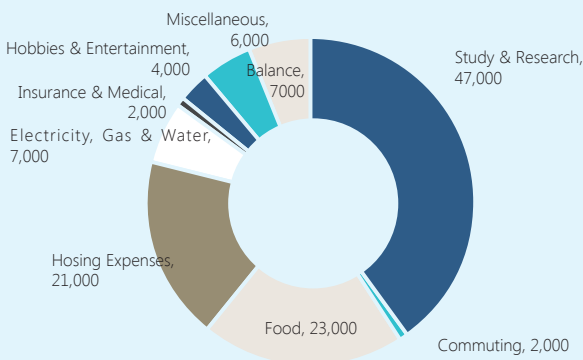
Average monthly expenses of international students by region
