After developing her career at multiple international organizations, she took up the post of Professor of International Relations at Hitotsubashi University in 2005. Afterwards, she has advanced her career by serving as the Assistant Administrator of the Crisis Response Unit at UNDP, and as the Special Adviser Ad Interim on Follow-up to the Summit on Addressing Large Movements of Refugees and Migrants. She took up her current position in May 2017.

Today, she will give a lecture on disarmament of WMD in terms of both nuclear and non-nuclear weapons, as well as on ATT, Cyber and AI technologies, urging overall understanding towards security and disarmament while sharing her ideas about the expected, possible, and emerging roles of the United Nations.
