4 Center of Excellence, and
4 Promising Research Initiatives have been Certified —

OSince 2014, Hiroshima University has been certifying researchers or research groups for either Center Of Excellence (=COE, i.e., research centers that can be expected to represent HU for a long term) or for Promising Research Initiatives (i.e., research groups wishing to be certified as COE). This clearly shows that Hiroshima University is committed to providing a focused research support to the researchers/research groups as a university.

OIn this fiscal year, the total of four entities have been newly certified for COE (three out of four entities are upgrades from the COE status), whereas the total of four entities for Promising Research Initiatives have been certified respectively.
