# **Background Information**

# City Exploration---- Wuhan

Performing arts cruise ship on the Yangtze River (夜游长江)



Close observation of Yangtze river, the longest river in Asia, and its beautiful scenery.



#### Hubei Provincial Museum in Wuhan (湖北省博物馆)



The center for collecting, studying, preserving and displaying historical and cultural relics in Hubei, especially famous for its collection of ancient relics from the tomb of marquis Yi of Zeng.

Jinli Village(锦里沟)



Located in Huangpi District, Jinli Village is the only Tujia Folk Cultural Tourist Area in Wuhan, famous for its beautiful scenery and typical cultural experience.

### Wuhan Han Show Theatre (汉秀剧场)



A place to appreciate Jing-Chu culture, a traditional culture in Wuhan city.

### Yellow Crane Tower (黄鹤楼)



Yellow Crane Tower is located on the snake Hill, the southern bank of Yangtze River.

It is well know as the "the best Pavilion of the world."

### City Exploration-----Xiamen (厦门)



Xiamen is an island city with a rich and dramatic history, replete with pirates, rebel leaders, and European merchants. Known in the West as Amoy, Xiamen has a long history as a port city. Today Xiamen is one of China's most attractive and best-maintained resort cities.

### City Exploration-----Quanzhou (泉州)



Famous as the start of the Maritime Silk Road and the largest port in Asia during the Song and Yuan dynasties, Quanzhou was once visited by legendary travelers, such as Marco Polo and Moroccan explorer Ibn Battuta, who compared Quanzhou to the Egyptian port of Alexandria.
